#### A problem doesn't mean it's bad

When a child has a problem at school, particularly with friendships or resilience in learning, it does not mean the child is bad. This is an idea our staff strongly believe, and it guides the way we work with our students. We all face problems throughout our lives and face them the best we can. Children don't have the same level of skills to help them to deal with problems on their own. It is normal that they need and seek support, and we encourage them to do this. If your child has a problem and their way of coping isn't as controlled or positive as it could have been, that is ok. They have done the best they can with the skills they have.

It is our job as adults, both at school and home, to have the conversations about their response and then build their skills in dealing with difficult situations. This is why our school has been using the Resilience Project and Mindful Aus to teach our students about their emotions, how to recognise them and respond to them in a beneficial way. So please remember if we ring home because your child has had a problem at school and it hasn't had a positive outcome, it is because we care and want to work as a team to ensure they have support to make a different choice next time.
